Board and batten siding is a versatile type of exterior siding that uses alternating wide boards and narrow strips, called battens, to create a rustic, layered look. It's often used on homes with a rural or rustic style, such as cottage, farmhouse, transitional and has made its way into many contemporary applications as well.

Here are some characteristics of board and batten siding

- Appearance: Creates a rustic, layered look with strong vertical lines that provide shadows and textures
- Origin: Originally used on outbuildings like barns and sheds to keep farm animals warm and reduce air leakage
- Installation: Board and Batten siding can be used for whole-house or accent applications.
- Style: Has surged in popularity with the rise of "modern farmhouse" and contemporary aesthetics
